The Massachusetts Department of Housing & Community Development has recently announced its CDBG grant round and application deadline. As a result of delays due to Covid, this year DHCD is combining two grant years, and as a result, the town of Truro has an opportunity to apply for up to \$1,700,000 as the lead community for a regional grant. We are proposing to submit the grant for four towns (Truro, Provincetown, Eastham & Harwich) to continue the popular housing rehabilitation and childcare subsidy programs.

The Housing Rehab Program would fund 27 households with a 0% interest deferred-payment forgivable loan, making repairs of up to \$50,000 to keep low and moderate-income residents in their homes. Code repairs, weatherization, and health and safety violations will continue to be the priority. All applicants are accepted on a first-come/first-served basis.

The Childcare Subsidy Program would provide up to \$7,000 per eligible child to subsidize care while parents work, go to school or seek employment. The funds go directly to the participating certified childcare provider based on the child's attendance. These funds subsidize the parent's payments on a sliding scale basis.

These two programs are well-known in the community and continue to have a long waitlist. As always there is no cost to the town and an enormous benefit to residents.

The following motion may be useful as you consider this vote:

<u>Proposed Motion</u>: Move to submit an FY22/23 CDBG grant for housing rehabilitation and childcare subsidies and to authorize the Town Manager or Designee to sign the grant application and associated forms.

<u>Proposed Motion:</u> Move to allocate \$50,000 from CDBG Miscellaneous Income to use as a contingency for the FY22/23 Housing Rehabilitation Program.



The second year of Truro's Childcare Voucher program has been operating since September and is successfully funding qualified families through the expanded program parameters.

Expanding the program, from only 2-year-olds last year to 0-4 now, and also including families who work for businesses based in Truro, has increased access dramatically and has been well received by local families & childcare providers.

We're currently in Phase I of the program, which ends on February 28th. Approved families were allocated half of the maximum award (\$3,750) for this period, and if re-verified for Phase II will be allocated the second half for a total of \$7,500 per year. Payment is made directly to the childcare provider, as reimbursement for the previous month's childcare costs.

The application window will open again for Phase II this winter, allowing new families another opportunity to apply.

The benefits of this program are wide-ranging. From the reduced financial burden on families, the support of local childcare providers after a challenging few years navigating Covid, and the wide-ranging draw to Truro for residents, town staff, and local businesses. This program emphasizes that Truro values local families and is committed to their well-being.

EXPLANATION: Members of the Select Board, Planning Board, Truro Housing Authority and Conservation Commission attended a presentation of the draft Housing Production Plan (HPP) on December 5, 2022. Each Massachusetts town must create a Housing Production Plan, a community's proactive strategy for planning and developing affordable housing. Through a HPP a community: 1) creates a strategy to enable it to meet its affordable housing needs in a manner consistent with the Chapter 40B statute and regulations, and 2) produces housing units in accordance with the HPP.

The HPP regulation is contained in 760 CMR 56.03(4). The approval process is identified in 760 CMR 56.03(4)(e)

(e) Review and Approval of Housing Production Plans. A HPP shall be adopted by the municipality's planning board, its conservation commission, and its select board or city council, following which the Chief Executive Officer may submit the HPP to the Department for its approval. The Department shall conduct an initial 30-day completeness review, and it will notify the municipality of any deficiency and offer an opportunity to remedy the deficiency. Within 90 days after the Department's finding that the HPP is complete, the Department shall approve the HPP if it meets the requirements specified herein; otherwise, it shall disapprove the HPP. The Department shall notify the municipality of its decision to either approve or disapprove a HPP in writing. If the Department disapproves a HPP, the notification shall include a statement of reasons for the disapproval. If the Department fails to mail notice of approval or disapproval of a HPP within 90 days after its receipt, it shall be deemed to be approved. A municipality that originally submitted a HPP that had been disapproved may submit a new or revised HPP to the Department at any time.

A municipality may amend its HPP from time to time if the Department approves the amendment upon the finding that the amended HPP meets the requirements of 760 CMR 56.03(4). The Department shall have the discretion to require the full 90-day review process for a major amendment to a HPP. A HPP shall be updated and renewed within five years of the date of its approval by the Department, through the full 90-day review process set forth above, or as the Department may otherwise require. The Department may, at its sole discretion, elect to treat a major amendment as a renewed HPP.

This agenda item will serve as an opportunity for the Board to discuss the December 5, 2022 presentation of the draft Housing Production Plan and to discuss a timeline for the Board's adoption of the Plan.

FINANCIAL SOURCE (IF APPLICABLE): The hiring of the consultant to create the HPP was paid for with funds from the Truro Housing Trust Fund.

IMPACT IF NOT APPROVED: The Town will not be able to add any new housing to its SHI or have a plan to guide its creation of housing that it vital to Truro's future.

The contents of this report are specified in the state law, M.G.L. Ch. 138 § 10A, which requires you to file this report.

Your annual report must contain only the following:

- 1) The number of licensees of each class granted;
- 2) The established schedule of fees for all classes of liquor licenses;
- 3) The revenue generated from these licenses;
- 4) A list of all violations of the law by licensees, which came to your attention; and
- 5) Your actions and findings regarding those violations.

The ABCC reviews these reports to assist in fulfilling its function of reporting on the conduct and condition of traffic in alcoholic beverages during the calendar year, developing recommendations for legislation that may be necessary or desirable for the better regulation and control of the traffic in alcoholic beverages and for the promotion of temperance in the use of alcoholic beverages.

To this end, your attention and cooperation in filing your annual reports on time is greatly appreciated. Reports should be received on or before February 15, 2023. If you do not file your report, you will not be in compliance with the law.

Select Board Meeting Minutes

December 13, 2022, Budget Task Force Meeting

Via GoToMeeting Platform

Select Board Members Present: Kristen Reed-Chair, Susan Areson-Member, Stephanie Rein-Member

Others Present: Darrin Tangeman-Town Manager, Kelly Clark-Assistant Town Manager, Chief of Police Jamie Calise, Police Administrative Assistant Michelle Thomas, Alex Lessin-Finance Director, Trudi Brazil-Town Accountant, Stephanie Costigan-School Superintendent

Chair Reed called the meeting to order at 8:30 am and noted no members of the Finance Committee were present.

Discuss/Review FY2024 Budget for the Police Department

Chair Reed recognized Chief Calise who presented a narrative summary for the Truro Police Department's 2024 fiscal year budget. Chief Calise briefly discussed the challenges for the department. In preparing his budget, Chief Calise focused on costs and inflation, best practices, legal requirements, and finally, recruitment and staffing. Chief Calise noted there were increases in lab fees and medical physicals for police officers, an increase in supplies to include fuel (\$4.50/gal.) and routine maintenance for vehicles. There has been a push throughout the Commonwealth for officers to wear body cameras. The Truro Police Department was successful in receiving a grant to purchase body cameras, associated equipment, and hardware. The grant did not cover the expense of maintenance costs and extended warranties which would cost approximately \$7,800 per year as reflected in the budget request.

Upon the completion of Chief Calise's presentation, Members asked Chief Calise about projected overtime, the impact of overtime costs with the hiring of one additional police officer, the establishment of a police academy on Cape Cod or access to a police academy closer to Truro, the challenges with recruiting and hiring new police officers, and the budget request for a School Resource Officer (SRO) at Truro Elementary School.

Chief Calise commented that it would take approximately 9 months from date of hire (background checks, preparation to attend the police academy, attend/graduate from the academy, and complete field training) for a police officer to fully serve on patrol. Chief Calise noted that the recruitment of police officers is currently the most challenging that he has seen in his 25-year law enforcement career. Chief Calise noted that Truro is now in competition with Provincetown for new police officers as Provincetown has now raised its top step to \$85,000 for a police officer and Truro's top step was \$70,000. Chief Calise hoped that the Budget Task Force would take this into account when reviewing the requested FY2024 budget.

Chief Calise noted that the Plymouth Police Academy is currently meeting the needs of the Truro Police Department's newly hired officers who require police academy training.

Chief Calise discussed the new Police Reform Bill and the impacts such as the removal of reserve and special police officers, police officer recertification requirements and timelines, work history information, internal investigations conducted, and training requirements.

A member of the public asked Chief Calise if the department is currently at full headcount and Chief Calise stated that the department was at full headcount at the beginning of the fall but that was no longer the case. The department recently had one retirement, one resignation, and one transfer to another department. Chief Calise noted that Provincetown has expanded to 21 police officers and Wellfleet has expanded to 18 police officers.

Chief Calise addressed the challenges of recruiting new police officers to Truro. Chief Calise briefly mentioned that a compensation analysis is currently underway, the aggressive expansion of marketing and advertising to draw qualified applicants, and the cost of housing in Truro makes it unaffordable to live for most police officers and their families.

Chief Calise described the role of an SRO, the SRO's responsibilities, and the benefits of an SRO to the community as well as the children. School Superintendent Costigan stated her support for an SRO and noted that she and Chief Calise have had several meetings to discuss the need for an SRO.

Chair Reed and Chief Calise discussed the previous grants awarded to Truro for the purchase of radios and body cameras.

Chair Reed recognized Town Manager Tangeman who said that the hiring of an SRO would require an override from Truro residents.

Chair Reed asked Chief Calise about the impacts of COVID-19 on the force and Chief Calise stated that the impacts have been less. The impact of COVID-19 has resulted in 15 overtime shifts at a cost of \$4,232.52.

Chair Reed thanked Chief Calise for his presentation and comments. Chair Reed also noted the professionalism of the Truro Police Department that has resulted in Truro being a very safe community. Chief Calise stated that it was due to the dedication and service performed by the police officers and staff at the Truro Police Department.

Member Areson made a motion to adjourn at 9:17 am.
Member Rein seconded the motion.
