- Ms. Gardner distributed the handout "Truro, Mass: Characteristics, themes, and ideas."
- Mr. Cook provided an overview of the Provincetown Independent's coverage of town seals and their inaccuracies.

The Committee reviewed and discussed the Draft Work Plan and proposed the following edits:

- 1.2 Discovery: Ms. Medley suggested public comment might be gathered in a public forum where constituents could contribute comments with Post-Its in guided categories.
- 2.1 Design Brief: Committee discussed grouping together categories of members that share similar interests such as Town employees, graphic professionals, arts organizations, etc.
- 2.2 Initial Concept Development and 4.2 Deliverable Preparation: Ms. Medley suggested that we include typography as a necessary part of the seal design.

Members agreed to bring their feedback to the next meeting in order to finalize and approve the Work Plan.

- Bring ideas on possible designers, artists, and firms to consider for the design work.
