#### 1. Call to Order

The meeting was called to order by Beth Cook.

## 2. Approval of Minutes

Minutes from the March 25th meeting were not available for review.

Approval was postponed to a future meeting.

#### 3. Election for CPC Liaison

- The committee **postponed** the election for the Rec Commission liaison to the Community Preservation Committee (CPC).
- Lindsay's term appears to be expiring, and the committee lacks a full five-member quorum.
- This agenda item will be revisited at a later date.

## 4. Director's Report (Presented by Damien Clements)

### Hiring Updates:

- Still seeking a replacement for Robin with OSTP.
- The Beach Office is accepting applications, but no sales clerks have been hired yet.
- o Lifeguard recruitment remains difficult.
- Summer recreation staffing is at 10 members, but some employees have conflicting availability due to vacations or sports.
- o Non-residents from Wellfleet and off-Cape are waitlisted while staff availability is determined.
- o Expected daily attendance: 55-60 kids.

## OSTP & Postseason Planning:

- o OSTP is fully staffed for Truro Central School (TCS) residents.
- o Wellfleet students, if verified as year-round residents, may also join postseason programming.

#### Swim Lessons:

- o There is still space available for swim lessons, which was unexpected.
- o Some usual attendees are enrolled in summer school, reducing participation.
- The collaboration with Wellfleet Rec has been positive, and the program structure is being evaluated for next year.

## • Financial Aid & Registration Process:

- Families seeking financial assistance for swim lessons can work with Dexter Keiser Fund or other local aid programs.
- The current sign-up process is complex, requiring a two-step system with Wellfleet Rec and Truro Rec.
- o Improvements to clarify instructions for future registrations are being considered.



## 5. Staffing & Scheduling Challenges

- Discussion on the use of scheduling software to track employee availability and optimize coverage.
- Recruiting independent contractors to provide flexibility.
- OSTP staff vacations and rotation planning discussed.

## 6. Community Engagement & Feedback

- A community engagement survey is being developed to gather input from families.
- Feedback regarding OSTP's structure, including extended hours and activities, was discussed.
- Consideration of implementing a Google Form with a QR code at sign-out for real-time parent feedback.

## 7. Walsh Property & Recreation Space Discussion

- Brian Boyle from the Truro Energy Committee reached out regarding potential indoor recreation space at the Walsh property.
- The concept would include multi-use fields, meeting space, and an indoor facility.
- Discussion about separating rec space from housing discussions to advance planning.

#### 8. Field Maintenance Concerns

- Issues with DPW maintenance of Baker's Field and other recreation spaces.
- Equipment and debris left untouched for years.
- Staff shortages and budgeting limitations have impacted regular upkeep.
