Minutes of the Meeting of the Water Resources Oversight Committee Thursday, February 26th 2015 4:00PM 1st Floor Meeting Room Truro Town Hall

Almy provided a printed time-line depicting the draft schedule of the activities comprising Phase II of the IWRMP. In addressing Task1, Greenhalgh handed out a draft of the Newsletter for distribution at the April Town Meeting, utilizing text provided by Almy. This will receive final editing at the next meeting.

Surface water monitoring will consist of three locations in East Harbor and two in the Pamet, not including any off-shore sites. Some components of sampling/analysis kits are on hand; Rex McKinsey may have some as well.

A discussion of the planned location of monitoring wells near East Harbor took place, leading to inclusion of historic wells; their location, condition and access. Pat Pajaron will be queried on this; Blake Martin may have some knowledge. Activity will start in March.


Worthington will get information on the Peters Hill spills: maps and location of sampling and mitigation wells from Provincetown.

The balance of the Nitrate Voluntary Sampling data is to be transferred to Almy.

Storm water BMPs will be collected from MassDOT, as well as county (ref. Scott Michaud) and Town sources, including Jay Norton of Truro's DPW. The purpose is not to construct regulatory protocols but guidance manuals for use by operators.

The WROC will hold another strategy session on March 12th
