- 5. Massachusetts Association of School Committees (MASC) Field Director James Hardy hosted a two hour workshop on the process of setting TSC goals. The committee discussed the dress code section of the handbook and whether some of the language was outdated, arbitrary and gender biased. The committee agrees the dress code should be based on safety. Superintendent Costigan stated the dress code is a TSC Policy. Superintendent Costigan suggested that as part of the Corrective Action for Tiered Monitoring Review that the Staff Code of Conduct Policy needs to be updated with the Student Dress Code Policy and to be on an upcoming policy subcommittee agenda. The committee will look at other districts' dress code policies. Once the dress code policy has been updated the Student Handbook will be redistributed to families in December. The committee would like the gender specific clothing items currently in the handbook to be deleted, and to keep the language related to safety. Vida Richter requested information on BMI testing for first and fourth grade students. Superintendent Costigan stated that BMI measures were a MA requirement. The parent receipt of reading the handbook should be at the beginning of the handbook rather than the end. On a roll call vote, 0 5.
