5.1 Superintendent - Superintendent Costigan reported on MCAS results and accountability. Truro Central School state profile can be found on the DESE website. MCAS ELA scores for TCS are slightly ahead of the state. However there is a decline in TCS scores from last year. The Literacy Committee has determined the decline is due to writing, written expression. MCAS math scores at TCS have improved. MCAS Science 5th grade students did very well. The TCS accountability score for Truro has dropped to Requiring Assistance or Intervention. The accountability score is affected by families refusing to take part in MCAS.

Superintendent Goals 23 - 24 - Superintendent Costigan discussed each goal and the different strategies of TSC administration and staff to accomplish these goals.

Student Learning Goal #1 - Diversity, Equity, Inclusion & Belonging

Goal - Throughout the 2023-24 school year, the Superintendent will empower educators and design opportunities to build and broaden the use of inclusive culturally responsive instructional strategies and increase the awareness and understanding of the role of social emotional learning in the classroom in order to create a school community where all students have a sense of belonging.

Goal - Communication and engagement with Truro Central School families will increase to provide complete transparency in our processes, procedures, and sharing of important information.


Impact: By providing consistent communication regarding our processes, procedures, and the sharing of important information, while also providing opportunities for families to come together, family engagement will increase at TCS.
