Library Director's report – Tricia Ford

- Rachel Baker-Holt has returned to Vassar. She made a big difference in working at the desk so other employees could stay focused on their work
- 84 young people participated in the Summer Reading Program
- COA fundraiser will be put off until at least October, Friends of COA will take over planning and execution
- State of the World event had about 200 people. Issue with speakers on left side of the room. Would have been better with a stage but there was an accessibility issue with one of the speakers. Speakers each gave speeches and there was less conversation than anticipated, but the content was powerful and appreciated.

- Katie Riconda contacted Tricia about New England FSA event, Jerry Leman discussing wind farms – will go forward

Library Leadership Transition Discussion

- Martha will be our point person for initial and final interviews
- Potential to have another person on the hiring committee, Darrin is looking for library directors. Question of conflict of interest.
- Kelly Sullivan Clark: Reached out to past trustee who doesn't have capacity to help at this time. Open meeting law issue in selecting final committee member. Considered a subcommittee if there are multiple members from the same committee. If the meeting is open, you could deter applicants and you are not protecting the sanctity of the questions.
- Question of having two trustees for the screening meeting and then having an open meeting for the final interview.
- Kelly: Appointed positions from town manager, town manager is not a public body, so he does not have to hire in an open meeting
 - Police chief and fire chief, final interviews were held in public session
- Martha: Why can we not follow that model?
- COA hiring of Michelle Peterson finalist committee was Darrin, Damion and Kelly. Question of whether there was another person on the committee
- Lack of clarity and possible disconnect between board and town hall regarding who will be the additional person on the hiring committee
- Discussion of practices in other towns, as reported by Provincetown Independent
- Martha fills the role of a library director. It would be great to have a community member or a Friend on the committee
- Ann Courtney: the Friends would like to have a representative on the committee. There's a lot of repair work that needs to happen in this community and giving community members a say will help with that repair.
- Kelly: Possible perception that Friend on the committee would be based on past donation to the library

- Ann Courtney: Contacted several towns regarding library hiring and they include a Friend on the hiring committee
- Helpful to have an odd number of people on a committee because it's easier to reach a majority in decisions
- Deadline is tight to find someone before Tricia leaves. Possibility of interim director

- Understanding community's intellectual needs
- Staff management and leadership, highlighting talents of staff members
 - Strong management skills without micromanaging
 - Understanding and valuing staff
- Awareness of current trends in library science
- Understanding of purpose of library
- Ability to work with town management, follow the Selectboard goals for the town, ability to collaborate and communicate with other departments
- Finances and Library Data abilities
- Expertise in diversity and inclusion of different groups including BIPOC,
 LGBTQ+, neurodiverse populations
- Flexibility and willingness to say, "Yes"
- Listener, someone who is in communication with community, openness to including community members How would you get to know the community and the resources in the community?
- Consideration of housing situation on Outer Cape
- Children and relationship to the school
- Hot Spot Policy and Form
 - Several edits
- Sustainable MOU discussion
 - Hoping to see examples of MOUs with other towns
 - Tricia will meet with Francine before the end of her tenure, but decision will fall to next director
