

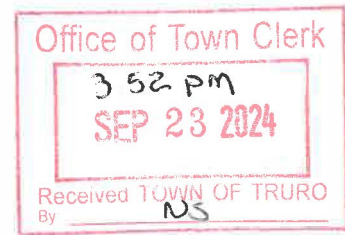


# Town of Truro

## Board of Registrars

### Meeting Minutes

July 31, 2024 – 4:00 pm

Chair Verde convened the meeting at 4:01 pm, Wednesday, July 31, 2024 held at the Town Hall and reviewed the topics for this meeting regarding the upcoming State Primary.

1. **Approval of September 3, 2024 State Primary Warrant**

Chair Verde reviewed the State Primary Warrant noting the process of review by the Select Board, posting by the Constable, and publishing in the newspaper. It was noted that the word “Selectmen” will be changed to “Select Board” on the Warrant. The Board did not have any questions.

**Vice Chair Sturdy seconded the motion.**

**Voted all in favor, 4-0-0, motion carries.**
