6. Other: Vote to adopt the town's decarbonization roadmap needed.

Bob Higgins-Steele and Lili Flanders, from the Green Communities division of the Massachusetts Dept. of Energy Resources (DOER), spoke of the benefits of participation in Climate Leaders to secure grant funding in addition to Green Communities grants. As pertains to the State's legally binding goal of zero emissions by 2025, a grant is currently in place to supply a road map of inventoried Town buildings through a DOER qualified consultant.

The Green Schools Program was referenced as a new and separate fund administered by the Mass Clean Energy Center, to be coordinated with the DOER and which will enable money to go directly to the Town.

Lili Flanders suggested moving to the vote as requested in this emergency meeting. Ken Oxtoby asked how this policy or Road Map affects the major roof project at the School already in place. Bob Higgins-Steele said Jared from DPW has been very helpful and noted the white roof being installed as a measure of policy effectiveness that will set precedence and continue through future repairs and renovations. Pete Cook spoke to move a motion on the decarbonization policy and table the Green Schools initiative to the August meeting with more information forthcoming.
