Dredging

Inner and approach harbor dredge completed, used three inclusion/exclusion days or whatever they are called, dredge departed Pamet 2/21/2019.

Basin is still an issue and it is highly unlikely it will be coordinated and completed prior to this years boating season. Potentially, there is a slight possibility the basin could be dredged in May or June, if not dredging will be targeted for a November, 2019, once the new 10 year permit is obtained.

Cameras

Harbormaster informed the committee the DPW had installed a third, 360 degree camera, which he knew nothing about, and was informed the camera view would be available to the public on a smart phone app. This camera was in addition to the two which had been previously authorized and installed a few years ago.

After much discussion centered primarily on the possibility the public might have total access to the cameras views, it was agreed Chair Timmy would go to town hall to determine the facts and it would be discussed at our next meeting. This was due to the fact a few years ago, when the first two cameras were set-up, the Harbor Commission was heavily involved in the ultimate decision and in this instance the Harbor Commission wasn't consulted at all.

Annual Revenues

Harbormaster reported this past years revenues collected were approximately \$20,000 over the previous years, in the \$95,000 range, due primarily to the newly enacted waterways fee.

Minutes

The December, 2018 and January, 2019 minutes were reviewed and approved

Miscellaneous

Various other marine related topics were discussed such as the Boston Boat Show, Schooney's new boat, whether Scott would ever get a new boat, and great white sharks.
