

Exemption for taxpayers renting year-round to Truro Residents.

In 2019 at Town Meeting, a home Rule Petition was submitted to propose to expand the Truro Residential Exemption. It was expanded to include: "a residential parcel occupied by a resident of the Town of Truro, other than the taxpayer, occupied on a year-round basis and used as his or her principal residence for income tax purposes." This exemption will exempt a portion of the taxes of owners who rent on a year-round basis to residents of Truro who use the rental as their principal residence for income tax purposes. This was approved by the Massachusetts Legislature in January 2021 to go into effect in Fiscal Year 2022.

The Select Board must vote to adopt a Residential Exemption as part of the Tax Rate setting process. Acceptance by the Select Board enables both versions of the Exemption. The exemption is revenue neutral; no additional revenue is raised by this action.

To qualify under the expanded version of the exemption for FY 2025, the applicant must provide either:

- 1. A signed (landlord and tenant) year-round lease beginning on or before January 1, 2024, and a copy of the first page of the renters 2023 Federal 1040 and State Income Tax Form 1 filing listing Truro as the mailing address. Inclusion of the tax forms is for residency verification only. All financial information can and should be redacted. OR:
- 2. A signed (landlord and tenant) year-round lease beginning on or before **January 1, 2024**, <u>and</u> a copy of the tenant's Driver's License listing the rental property address. Additionally, the tenant must satisfy <u>two</u> of the following: a 2024 motor vehicle excise bill paid; be registered to vote in Truro as of Jan 1, 2024; be on the Town Census as of Jan 1, 2024 or provide a copy of a December 2023 utility bill in the tenant's name for the rental address.

As with a traditional Residential Exemption, properties receiving the Expanded Residential Exemption, the taxable value will be lowered by a fixed amount before the tax rate is applied. For FY 2024, the amount was \$312,841. Here is an example of how the exemption works:

In addition to a completed, signed application form, the required supporting documentation must be included as listed above. It is recommended tenants are asked to immediately register with the Clerk to register for Voting and Census lists as well as updating their address and vehicle garaging with the Registry of Motor Vehicles. If tenant's tax returns are used as supporting documentation and a post office box is their primary mailing address, the tax return page showing the PO Box must accompany the application, along with a copy of both sides of their driver's license. This documentation is required to be in place prior to/as of Jan 1, 2024. Please understand there can be no exceptions to ensure everyone is treated fairly and equally. This exemption is not automatic; applications must be completed annually to receive the Expanded Residential Exemption.

Applications received prior to August 31, 2024, will be applied to the Fall 2024 tax bill. Qualifying applications received between Sept 1, 2024, and April 1, 2025, will be handled as a standard exemption and will have their adjustment applied to the Spring 2025 Tax Bill.
